IMPORTANT NOTICE

Any person wishing to object to any fee application, or the Final Report, must file a written objection within 20 days of the date of this notice, together with a request for a hearing, and serve a copy of the objections upon the Trustee, any party whose application is being challenged, and the United States Trustee. You will be given further notice of any hearing on your objections. If no timely objections are filed, the court will act on the fee application(s) and the Trustee may pay dividends pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3009 without further notice or hearing, or order of the court.

Upon the Trustee's distribution of all funds held by the estate, the Trustee will file a Final Account, Certification that the Estate has been Fully Administered, and Application to be Discharged. This Final Account is due 125 days after the date of the order approving the final applications for compensation by the Trustee and any professionals employed by the Trustee. If no objection is filed within 30 days after the Final Account is filed, there shall be a presumption that the estate has been fully administered, and the court will discharge the Trustee from further duties as trustee and close the case.
