
Debtor requests an extension to: May 5, 2003

Reason extension requested: The Debtor is an airline primarily engaged in operations in Hawaii, the mainland United States and the South Pacific. The Debtor employs approximately 3,000 employees and has over ten thousand creditors and parties in interest. Given the size and complexity of the Debtor's operations and the fact that certain prepetition invoices have not yet been received or entered into the Debtor's financing accounting systems, the Debtor needs an additional thirty (30) days to compile the information necessary to prepare and file its Schedules and Statement of Financial Affairs.

Debtor understands that this motion and a proposed order shall be submitted for approval to the Chapter 13 Trustee in a chapter 13 case, and to the Office of the United States Trustee in a chapter 11 case.

Debtor further acknowledges that failure to file the required documents by any extended deadline will result in dismissal of the case with a bar to refiling a subsequent bankruptcy petition for 180 days following the entry of the dismissal order, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §109(g)(1).

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Upon the motion of Hawaiian Airlines, Inc. (the "Debtor"), the debtor and debtor in possession in the above-captioned chapter 11 case, for an order granting the Debtor a thirty (30) day extension to file its Schedules and Statement of Financial Affairs (the "Motion"); the Court finds that (i) it has jurisdiction over the matters raised in the Motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; (ii) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157(b)(2); (iii) the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtor, its estate and its creditors; (iv) proper and adequate notice of the Motion and the hearing thereon has been given and that no other or further notice is necessary; and (v) upon the record herein, after due deliberation thereon, good and sufficient cause exists for the granting of the relief as set forth herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND  
DECREED THAT:

1. The Motion is GRANTED in its entirety.
2. The Court hereby extends the fifteen-day period for the Debtor to file its Schedules and Statement of Financial Affairs pursuant to Rules 1007(a)(4) and 1007(c) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure for an additional thirty (30) days, so that such Schedules and Statement of Financial Affairs shall be due no later than May 5, 2003.
3. The relief granted in this Order is without prejudice to the Debtor's right to seek an additional extension to file its Schedules and Statement of Financial Affairs if cause so exists.
