**NOTICE OF POLICY ON FEES FOR ADMISSION TO PRACTICE**

On February 4, 2002 the U.S. District Court raised to \$100.00 the fee for admission to practice and the fee for limited admission to appear before the court *pro hac vice*.

As a unit of the District Court, the Bankruptcy Court limits practice before it to attorneys admitted to membership in the bar of the District Court for the District of Hawaii. Pursuant to LR 83.1(e), made applicable by LBR 1001-2(a)(10), an attorney not a member of this bar may apply for permission to appear *pro hac vice* in a particular matter.

Effective immediately, an application filed in the Bankruptcy Court for permission to appear *pro hac vice* must be accompanied by a check in the amount of \$100. Because this assessment is being collected on behalf of the District Court, the check must be made payable to “**Clerk, U.S. District Court.**” The assessment will be transmitted to the District Court upon approval of the application. In the event the application is denied, a refund will be sent to the applicant, pursuant to LR 83.1(e).
