**ORDER REGARDING CONVERSION OF CHAPTER 7 CASES**

On February 21, 2007, the Court held in Marrama v. Citizens Bank of Massachusetts, \_\_\_ U.S. \_\_\_, 2007 WL 517340 (Feb. 21, 2007), that a bankruptcy court may deny a debtor's motion to convert a case under 11 U.S.C. § 706.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, effective immediately, a request to convert a case under 11 U.S.C. § 706(a) must be by motion served on the Office of the United States Trustee, the case trustee, and all parties receiving notice electronically through the court's transmission facilities (CM/ECF Notice of Electronic Filing). The motion must include the following provision: "If no objection to the motion to convert this case is filed within 10 days after the date the motion was filed, the court may enter an order granting the motion without further notice or hearing."
