**ORDER RESCINDING ORDER ADOPTING INTERIM RULES**

On October 14, 2005, the court adopted as Interim Rules certain Amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure prepared by the Advisory Committee of the Judicial Conference of the United States, designed to implement the substantive and procedural changes mandated by the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005. Unless Congress acts to the contrary, the Interim Rules adopted by the court will be superseded by new rules and amendments that will take effect on December 1, 2008.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Order Adopting Interim Rules Governing Practice and Procedure in Bankruptcy Cases issued October 14, 2005, is RESCINDED, effective December 1, 2008.
