eOrders Overview

- Orders “uploaded” like eDocs, not filed in case
- Efficient routing system within court
- Allows judge to sign orders remotely
- Judge’s electronic signature at top of first page
- Deficient orders emailed back to submitter
- ECF filers can check status of order

Do Not Upload:

- Proposed FOF/COLs
- Orders that a party entitled to approve form order has failed or refused to do so timely
- Orders accompanied by letter of explanation or redlined version



The above types of orders should be emailed as editable word processing (not PDF) files to orders@hib.uscourts.gov.

Format

- Reserve top 3 inches of first page for judge's signature
- Type "END OF ORDER" centered, at end of order's text
- Below "END OF ORDER":
 - Stipulation signatures / "Approved as to form"
 - Submitting attorney info
- Form orders must be "flattened" PDFs

- **Order -- No Related Motion** for orders that are not directly related to a motion, such as a stipulated or agreed order, a judgment, or a wage order.






LBR 9009-1. Forms

The clerk may issue local forms for use under the Bankruptcy Code, Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, and the Local Bankruptcy Rules. References in these rules to use of a form substantially conforming to a prescribed local form means that the filer must provide the information requested in the local form.


- NO – Forms may not fit all situations
- However, forms reflect what information the court considers essential or useful – in drafting a custom motion or order, make sure to include the information requested in the form

PDFs – Browser Compatibility

- Some browsers may not open a PDF form:




- Download the file - usually by right-clicking and selecting “Save” or “Save Page/Target As”



PDFs – “Flattening”

- Some fillable PDFs may not save the data you enter when uploaded in CM/ECF or may not be viewable on devices such as an iPad
- You must “Print to PDF” or print on paper and scan to make PDF; Print to make warning message disappear:

**General procedural guidelines - judge may always require hearing or dispense with hearing.*

Withdrawal of Counsel

- Court approval always required in an AP
- Approval needed in a Bankruptcy Case if:
 - Representing Debtor
 - Approved for employment by trustee/committee
 - Involved in pending contested matter

When is it Not Withdrawal?

- Does not include situations where one attorney in a firm is leaving and firm will continue representing client – Use Notice of Change of Firm Affiliation
- In an Adversary Proceeding, debtor's attorney may file a Statement of Non-Representation if no agreement for such representation – BUT attorney must still be served initial complaint – See Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7004(g)

Withdrawal: No Approval Needed

- If court approval is not required, an attorney may file a Notice of Withdrawal of Counsel and Request for Removal from Notice List
- Provide address if client wants notices (e.g., of discharge, dismissal, etc.)

 - A debtor’s attorney cannot complete this filing

- Termination will stop notices of electronic filing (NEFs) on day after filing this in CM/ECF
