**ORDER AUTHORIZING PRO BONO  
LIMITED SCOPE REPRESENTATION**

In order to promote access to justice by pro se debtors in bankruptcy cases and adversary proceedings, the following provision creates an exception to the requirement for a debtor's attorney's continuing representation under LBR 9011-1.

An attorney may limit the scope of representation of a debtor in a bankruptcy case or adversary proceeding if:

- (1) The attorney is appointed as pro bono counsel in accordance with a court-sponsored program, or
- (2) The attorney files a statement that specified short-term limited legal services are being provided without compensation under the auspices of a program sponsored by a nonprofit organization, and are governed by Rule 6.5(a) of the Hawaii Rules of Professional Conduct.
